Applicants would need the following personal attributes:

- The ability to take a leadership role and to show initiative in work-related situations but also be able to work successfully as part of a team.
- An attitude of life-long learning with regards to teaching methodologies and the acquisition of knowledge related to the subject.

Necessary qualifications and skills would include:

- A relevant Bachelor's degree and teaching diploma would be the minimum requirements.
- The candidate must be qualified to teach Physics to Grade 12 level.
- A minimum of 3 years teaching experience of Physics at Grade 12 level would be an advantage.
- SACE registration.
- A valid and up to date Police clearance.
- To be highly articulate, confident and competent in the delivery of subject content and skills.
- Good computer skills with regards to lesson preparation, presentation and general school administration.
- Excellent classroom management skills and the ability to develop positive relationships with the learners.
